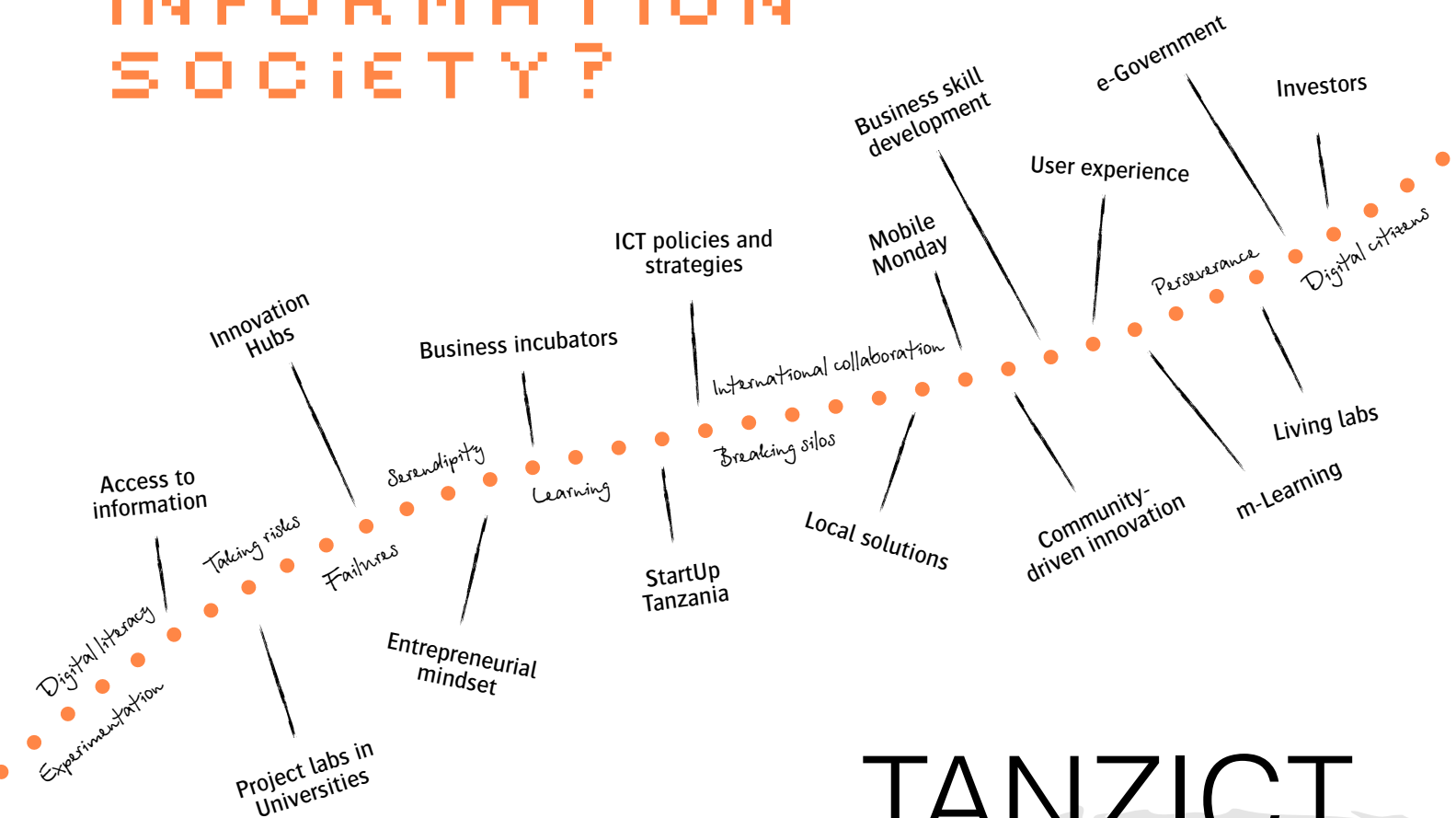


WHAT IS THE ROADMAP FOR A TANZANIAN INFORMATION SOCIETY?

Objective

Renew Tanzania's National ICT Policy and start the implementation.

Questions

- What is an information society in Tanzanian context?
- How can we ensure the updated ICT policy will be relevant for the next 10 years?
- How can ICT support development in different sectors? How to include them in the renewal process?
- How does ICT in practise contribute to Tanzania's socio-economic goals?
- How can ICT enhance the lives of children, women and vulnerable groups?

Objective

Strengthen the institutional capacity of the Ministry of Communications, Science and Technology to act as role model in the use of ICT for other ministries and governmental agencies.

Questions

- How can the MCST pilot the use of new technologies in-house for developing processes?
- How does the MCST staff create and share knowledge internally and externally?
- Is a new corporate ICT policy enough to facilitate the desired change in the use of ICT tools?
- Where are the most interesting models and ICT tools to be experimented with?

Objective

Create a seamless ICT innovation chain from ideas to pilots, raising awareness of innovations as drivers of economic and social development.

Questions

- How do we involve all stakeholders and communities in the co-creation of the innovation chain?
- What kind of new funding models are needed to support young new ICT entrepreneurs?
- How can we facilitate the entrepreneurial and innovative mindset in university students?
- How could living labs be used in the Tanzanian context to co-create and test new business ideas?
